It is acceptable for applicants to have research experience in other similar field such as public administration, or a combination of public administration and economics.

Skills in econometrics and measurement of local economic development, cost-benefit analyses, economic governance of the public sector

PhD in economics, minimum 6 articles, chapters in books or books (single author or co-authored) – minimum 2 articles need to be ISI, certificate attesting the mastering of English language, with the exception of the situation that the candidate pursued a degree (bachelor, master or PhD in English)
